**I. Questions and Answers:**

1	Does the subconsultant need to be prequalified in all area classes or only in the area class in which they are performing work?	As posted in Addendum One (1), the area class for this solicitation for both the Prime Consultant and the Sub – Consultants must be prequalified in 8.01 only.
2	If our firm is a sub consultant member of the “Program Management” Team for the TIA projects, are you prohibited from submitting on this CEI RFQ, either as a Prime <u>or</u> Sub?	No one is prohibited from submitting on the RFQ. However, all respondents should adhere to the conflict of interest policy attached to the RFQ as Exhibit IV. The Department will evaluate conflicts of interest and any impacts based on how respondents with potential conflicts intend to mitigate the potential conflicts.
3	What extent will selected organization be expected to conduct materials sampling and testing as described in Section F, 2 <sup>nd</sup> paragraph, of Scope of Services on page 4 of 24?	Material testing, outside of routine field tests, is not included in the scope of services for this solicitation. Routine testing may include but is not limited to concrete air and slump tests, in-place materials acceptance, concrete cylinders, etc.

4	<p>On page 15 of 24 of the referenced RFQ, after paragraph 4 there appears to be missing text. Please clarify if the intent is to provide for the other team members the same information requested from the prime in paragraph 3, items a thru d.</p>	<p><b>Number 4 on page 15 of 24</b> should read as follows:</p> <p>4. Provide information on the overall team’s experience (<b>excluding the prime</b>) and ability in delivering effective services for projects of similar complexity, size, scope, and function. Describe no more than five (5) and no less than three (3) projects, in order of most relevant to least relevant, which demonstrate the firm’s capabilities to provide services for GDOT. For each project, the following information should be provided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Client name, project location and dates during which services were performed.</li> <li>b. Clear description of overall project and services performed by your firm.</li> <li>c. Exact duration of project services provided by your firm, and overall project budget.</li> <li>d. Client(s) current contact information including contact names and telephone numbers.</li> </ul>
5	<p>Can the firm that is successful in landing this contract participate in Preconstruction Activities on Projects in the Investment lists within areas that passed TIA?</p>	<p>See the answer to question #2 in this addendum.</p>
6	<p>In the advertisement “Job Descriptions and Qualifications” are specified starting on page 6. “Experience and Qualifications” starts on page 14. Within Experience and Qualifications the resumes to submit are very specific and suggest that submittal of any others are not to be considered. Should the positions mentioned in the Job Descriptions and Qualifications have resumes submitted as well? For example, Major Bridge Lead Inspector and ATMS/Signal Inspector.</p>	<p>The resumes that need to be submitted are on page 14, under C. Experience and Qualifications. Please follow the instructions accordingly.</p>
7	<p>When will the “selected TIA Band 1 projects to be designed and constructed by GDOT” list be made available to interested firms?</p>	<p>The construction of some of the band 1 projects will be managed by the local governments and GDOT CEI services will not be necessary. GDOT is continuing to coordinate with the local governments on delivery responsibilities. The total band 1 project list is available on GDOT’s TIA webpage.</p>
8	<p>Will the selected firm have access to GDOT local laboratory’s for required materials testing purposes outside of routine field tests, since the 6.04 series were not a part of the prequalification requests?</p>	<p>Material testing, outside of routine field tests, is not included in the scope of services for this solicitation. Routine testing may include but is not limited to concrete air and slump tests, in-place materials acceptance, concrete cylinders, etc. GDOT anticipates the Office of Materials and Research to perform lab tests on the projects.</p>
